

Web Page Requirements - Project Checklist

- 1. Title & Logo – 10 points**

A title and logo should appear at the top of the web page. The title needs to be in a larger font (when compared to text on the page) and a logo/picture connected to the topic needs to be incorporated and positioned around the title.
- 2. Research Graphic Organizer– 30 points (15 pts. Research – 15 pts. G.O.)**

The research graphic organizer will help “organize” information into the essay. An introduction and conclusion must be created as well. Use bullets or numbers to list information. Any research gathered from the web will be printed, read, and highlighted. All research must be attached to the research graphic organizer. A minimum of three sources is required.
- 3. Collins Writing – 40 points**

The introduction and general information section will provide a brief description of the research topic, providing some detail (a summary of the topic chosen). Use the Collins Type 3, incorporate the FCAs, and construct an informative essay. Once the essay has been edited, a typed version will be posted to the web page.
- 4. Pictures – 15 points**

A minimum of ten pictures must be included in the web page. Each picture should be directly connected to the topic being presented. Pictures do not need to be cited for the works cited page. Pictures must connect to the topic. The logo does not count as a picture.
- 5. Create A Graph – 30 points**

Create two bar graphs and/or pie charts and incorporate each graph into the web page. The graphs will showcase statistical information gathered through research. Be sure to title each graph accordingly, in addition to citing each graph.
- 6. (2) YouTube Videos – 25 points**

Two videos or video clips must be included. Videos can be accessed using YouTube. Videos must correlate to the topic presented.
- 7. Links Section – 25 points**

Five web pages that provide additional information must be included and/or are related to the topic.
- 8. Works Cited – 10 points**

Follow the directions on the Works Cited graphic organizer.
- 9. Creativity – Color – Spelling – Format – 15 points**

Creativity and color go hand in hand. Be sure to create a web page that is “user friendly.” Colors and design will determine how friendly the web page is. Use the spellchecker once the page is completed. Spelling is also a key component of a functional webpage.
