- _____/10 **Slide #4 - Hotel Information** – **title**, along with **picture** of **hotel** and **description** (amenities)
- _____/40 **Slide #5 through Slide #7 – Excursion Information** – Each slide must have a **title**, **pictures**, and a description taken from research (**use bullets or numbers to highlight key details in the excursion**)
- _____/5 **Slide #8 – Conclusion** – *Why* should we purchase the trip? Wrap up the presentation, bring it all to an end. Use **numbers** or **bullets** to highlight key parts of the trip, add **pictures**
- _____/5 **Spelling/Grammar** – Be sure to **proofread** the presentation prior to presenting.
- _____/10 **Format** – The **overall organization** of the Slide presentation, which includes slide **transitions**.
